Scholarship Guidelines and Procedures

I. ELIGIBILITY:

A. Applicant/s must be currently engaged in the study and promotion of one or more of the following areas:

1. Music
2. Fine Arts / Graphic Design
3. Dance
4. Film/Video
5. Performing Arts
6. Creative Writing
7. Fashion Design

B. Applicant/s must be able to meet all of the following scholarship requirements:

1. Legal resident of the Los Angeles County or surrounding areas
2. Demonstrate ability in your chosen field
3. Recommendations from **League** sponsor and / or outside reference who will support the ability, character, and integrity of the applicant/s as well as potential contribution to the greater community
4. Supportive statement from the applicant/s as to your goals and potential contribution to the greater community
5. Submit a current photograph
6. Submit samples of work (i.e. DVD or Jump Drive)
7. Prepare for an interview
8. Submit a letter of acceptance from the school to which you have applied

II. SAMPLE OF WORK:

A. Applicant must pay special attention to the quality and relevance of the work sample submitted. **NOTE:** Do not submit original art work.

1. VISUAL ARTS: Submit a DVD or Jump Drive of your original art work. We would like you to display your originals on the day of your interview.
2. DANCE, THEATER: Submit a DVD or a Jump Drive
3. MUSIC: Submit a DVD or a Jump Drive

4. MEDIA: Submit a DVD, CD or a Jump Drive
5. FASHION DESIGN: Submit a DVD of your original designs. We would like you to display your designs on the day of your interview.
6. CREATIVE WRITING: Submit a short story with approximately _____ words. It should be type written. A poem should contain _____ type written words.
